Crop	Stage	Agro meteorological Advisories
General reco	mmendations	The temperature is likely to rise. Avoid direct sunlight between 11 pm and 3 pm. Irrigation should be continued.
Banana	Vegetative	Bunches in Nendran banana, will be initiated during this month. For proper growth and development of bunches give adequate irrigation.
Coconut	Growth stage	As the dry weather is persisting, ensure soil moisture and provide adequate irrigation in coconut gardens. Avoid irrigation during direct sunshine hours. Water supply through drip irrigation saves water loss. Provide mulching for protection against temperature.
Cowpea	Vegetative	As high temperature is prevailing, sucking pests like thrips, aphids and whiteflies might increase in cowpea. Spray 2% neem oil garlic emulsion on the leaves at two weeks interval.
Amaranthus	Vegetative	Spray 10g crushed chilli and 10 ml cow's urine in 1 litre of water for the control of leaf webber in amaranthus.
Chilli	Vegetative	To control whiteflies in chilli spray 2% neem oil garlic emulsion.
