Cardamom (Maturation to harvest)	Clum rot/Azhukal/capsule rot	Apply mulch and clean the drainage channels. Farmers are advised to keep vigilance against Shoot/panicle borer
Coconut (Different stages)	Red palm weevil Rhinoceros Beetle Stem bleeding Leaf rot	Improvedrainage facility. Avoid the application of fertilizers and plant protection chemicals.
Arecanut (Nut development)	Mahali	Take necessary phyto-sanitary measures and provide proper drainage facilities
Pepper (berry development)	Quick Wilt	Improvedrainage facility. Avoid the application of fertilizers and plant protection chemicals.
Banana (Different stages)	Bunchy top Rhizome weevil	Farmers are advised to provide propping to standing banana crop as there is chance of high wind speed in the coming dates. Clean the drainage channels. As there is chance of Pseudo stem weevil infestation farmers are advised to adopt strict phyto-sanitary measures.
Ginger/Turmeric (Vegetative)	Ginger blast Shoot borer Rot and wilt diseases	Improve drainage facility by providing proper drainage channels
Coffee (Berry development)	White Stem borer Leaf rust	Improve drainage . Fertilizer application shall be postponed
Animal Husbandry	Caring	Avoiding moisture in places where cattle feeds are being stored reduce the chances of food poison. livestock shed and premises should be kept clean by the proper disposal of food waste for avoiding <i>Leptospirosis</i> .
